21st TOURNAMENT RULES 2010 EDITION

EUROP'foot Association organizes a tournament of young players in the Under 15 category official open to European teams' UEFA "belonging to" United Nations FIFA " on grounds of Echallonnières and Vertou at City Center, Sports Complex Cross of Sizes at High Goulainé.

ART.1: Any team involved in the test consists of 11 players and 5 alternates, born from 1 January 1995,

Licensed in the National Federation of the country to which it belongs.

specific paragraphs in the tournament:

- a) Replace the "game sheet" with presentation of licenses upon arrival at the Center for Management of the tournament.
- b) Any player dismissed in a club other than that committed can not participate in the tournament.
- c) Only 16 players listed on the sheet and after verification of licenses are allowed to play.
- d) Only 16 players and 3 officials on the record sheet will be on the podium at the awards ceremony.

ART.2: The tournament starts on Saturday afternoon with a preliminary round (championship formula). After the draw,

Teams are divided into 6 groups of 4 teams. The first 6 and the two best runners of the 6 groups accessing the "quarter-finals." The other 4 second and 4 third best contribute to the 9th to 16th place. The 8 remaining teams compete in the 17th to 24th place. The Challenge Vincent Girard is awarded to the best French team.

specific paragraphs in the tournament:

- a) In the preliminary round on Saturday, in case of equality of two or more teams, priority will be given in descending order: goal difference, highest number of matches won, best offense, the fewest penalties in the draw lots. victory with 2 goals difference: 5 pts victory _: _ 4 pts with zero goals: 3 pts no profit _ 2 _ lost pts: 1 pt
Package: 0 pt _ penalty: -1 pt
- b) For the finals and classification matches on Sunday in a tie, there will be "shot on goal" by 3 different players and if another tie, continue with other players, until the failure of a player from another.

ART.3: Arbitration is conducted by umpires FFF requested by the Europ'foot and extras by name statement on the tournament having received permission from the Atlantic District. Laws of the

specific paragraphs in the tournament:

a) The matches take place in mid-time 2x12 minutes. No extension. The cumulative playing time per player will not

exceeds the regulatory requirements defined by the Atlantic District for a day of tournament official time

category x 1.5 (2x40' = 80'x1.5 = <120') For every game he is allowed 3 substitutions during play, to stop playing

and permission of the referee. The other replacements are offside at halftime. Players become substitutes replaced.

b) A yellow card results in the release of players for 5 minutes without replacement.

Two yellow cards results in exclusion of the player for the rest of the match without replacement.

A red card results in the exclusion of the player without replacement and automatic suspension for the next game.

Any player excluded by red card, not respecting the automatic suspension of the match following his team will

penalized per game lost with -1 point and 2 goals against and exclusion of the player for the rest of the tournament.

The team then opposed a total victory to 5 points with 2 goals.

c) The arbitrators have, upon their arrival at the Center of Management, they mediate in formal attire.

The appointment of arbitrators of meetings is available to them. The transmission of results and observations are done using

a "game sheet" The central arbiter can arbitrate the club to which he belongs. The referees are responsible for

enforce the schedule, playing time and schedule meetings. Any team not present at game time posted

is declared "forfeited" with 0 points and 2 goals against for 5 points and 2 goals to the opposing team.

d) Each team will be equipped with 2 sets of jerseys of different colors. Draw stiffening if necessary.

ART.4: EUROP'foot The association will arrange to carry out its responsibilities as an organizer:

A central home sound system and tournament management, interpretation, display responsibilities, relief.

Accompaniment accommodation and meals, planning schedules and venues of meetings, shuttle transportation.

Arbitration and Police Field. Displaying results of the preliminary round on Saturday with rankings and communication

places and times of matches on Sunday. Time and place trophy ceremony. Meals and drinks on site. specific paragraphs in the tournament:

a) full, players, teachers, referees, team managers, spectators, undertakes to respect the spirit of the tournament.

b) Each player, manager or educator, is committed to the arbitration and settlement of the tournament.

c) In relation to a dispute or misunderstanding, only members of the Steering Committee, references

to this Regulation,

d) The Association disclaims any liability for bodily injury, theft and damage to property and equipment

outside the organization of the tournament.
